Authored over 400 Supreme and Appellate Court briefs and argued before these courts on numerous occasions. Served as City of Springfield hearing officer presiding over criminal and zoning violations. Served as mediator at the request of both plaintiffs and insurance companies. Speaker at many continuing education seminars at the request of ISBA, IITLA, IICLE and others. ## Key Accomplishments
